

Graduating May 2024

- File online before October 1, 2023
- Return Senior Checklist: December 1, 2023

Graduating August 2024

- File online before February 2, 2024
- Return Senior Checklist: April 1, 2024
- * Declare all majors/minors prior to applying for graduation.
- * Complete your senior checklist to be eligible to graduate.
- * August graduates participate in the May graduation ceremony; no special permission needed.







Required Workshops for Teacher Certification

Safe Schools, Healthy Students (SSHS 1020)

SSHS 1020 is an online workshop administered through the Division of Extended Learning, and fulfills the New York State workshop requirement for those completing a teacher preparation program through a college. Topics include: Child Abuse Recognition and Reporting; School Violence Prevention and Intervention (SAVE); Fire and Arson Prevention; Highway Safety and Traffic Regulations and School Safety Patrols; Prevention of Child Abduction; Prevention of Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Abuse.
