What is Leadership Oswego County?

Leadership Oswego County is a community program administered by SUNY Oswego's Office of Business and Community Relations. The Leadership Oswego County program explores community trusteeship, leadership skills, current issues and networking with a diverse group of community residents. Key community members mentor and share with participants the skills and knowledge needed to be effective leaders. Graduates of the program are better prepared to serve the community in the roles of board member, citizen, employee or volunteer with organizations that serve Central New York.

Leadership Oswego County prepares a select group of county residents to become the community stewards of the future. This group embarks on a nine-month course on Oswego County and its resources, vital issues of today, and visioning for tomorrow.

The **MISSION** of Leadership Oswego County is to educate committed citizens to become a well-informed, engaged, and diverse network of community stewards.

The **VISION** of Leadership Oswego County is to develop a group of leaders who will apply their collective experiences and skills to broaden our community's vision and improve the quality of life for all Oswego County residents.

Who benefits from the program?

Local **EMPLOYERS** find that the program provides an invaluable learning experience for their employees by developing their leadership potential and organizational and problem-solving skills, while providing access to a broad network of community professionals and resources.

Our **COMMUNITY** benefits from Leadership Oswego County by having a committed and knowledgeable group of graduates who are prepared to become trustees of our community's future.

Our **PARTICIPANTS** gain a greater understanding of the role of "community steward" through exploring issues and opportunities relevant to Oswego County.

Who should apply?

Applications directly from interested individuals are encouraged, as are nominations of employees from area businesses and organizations. An ideal candidate is someone who:

- Is interested in the future of Oswego County and is willing to help shape it.
- Has a sincere interest in seeking public office or board leadership roles.
- Is able to commit the time and energy needed to complete the program.
- Demonstrates leadership qualities in their professional and/or personal life.

Tuition

Business Rate: \$750 • Non-profit and Self-pay Rate: \$400

Scholarships are available for self-payment participants who demonstrate need.

Tuition includes a full day in-person conference in September, a hybrid style class schedule with both virtual and in-person meetings running October–May, lunch and snacks provided for all in-person classes, an end of the year retreat, and graduation dinner in June.

2022 LOC Class Project

The LOC class of '22 brought forth three potential project ideas through a brainstorming meeting and voted as a group to decide which to pursue. The class agreed the project with the most potential impact and the most involvement for everyone would be to lend support to Oswego county volunteer fire departments during their Recruit NY events in April. This idea was sparked by class member Ashley Haskins who is herself a volunteer firefighter.

Tara Allen Magner, Erin Palmitese, Kathryn Woodworth and Ashley became our department chiefs by coordinating class meetings and keeping detailed notes. They made sure that our "paint done" was defined and formulated polls to ensure the group was in consensus throughout the process. Ashley made sure that everyone in the class had access to the department contact information, and then we as a class divided and conquered. Each potential department was assigned two LOC class representatives, and their department-specific requirements were gathered through a survey. Everyone got involved to lend a hand in various capacities including graphic design, social media outreach, word of mouth outreach, event assistance, and miscellaneous support. We were also featured on the local news in support of this project to help spread the word across the community.

Jay Hy and John Rey fought the fire with the video they filmed at local departments to visually illustrate the need for volunteers and better explain what that entails. This video has been seen hundreds of times now on YouTube and has been given to all

the departments for future use. Shauna Nesbitt climbed the ladder above and beyond by finding as much additional information as possible about Recruit NY. She put together a presentation on the benefits of being a volunteer firefighter which was shared with each of the departments. There were things she found that some existing volunteer firefighters weren't even aware of!

We had people on-site at the departments for each event we were involved in and learned a great deal about what it takes to respond as a firefighter. Overall we received excellent feedback from the stations, and the events resulted in a few new volunteers. The need for additional volunteers is an important one for our communities to understand and the stations appreciated our help in spreading the word and getting involved. Paraphrasing from one of the volunteers we spoke to during their event, "The people who are calling for help are having their worse day. We want to be able to respond to everyone on that day. If we don't have enough volunteers that worse day could become their last."

In addition to our larger volunteer firefighter project, Heather Richer organized our class putting together playground equipment at Camp Hollis, and Elizabeth Weimer coordinated personal care item donations from our whole class to food pantries across the county. Our class has come together to positively impact our community in many ways, and has become a tighter knit group in the process. It was an exciting year to get involved and make a difference.


