RE: 54-hour limit for the Philosophy-Psychology degree

We move that Philosophy and Psychology be recognized as two separate disciplines. Since the 54 hour rule applies to disciplines, this would mean that students would be restricted only from taking more than 54 hours in either discipline; that is, students majoring in the Philosophy-Psychology program would not have their classes in both disciplines added together in order to determine whether they had surpassed 54 hours in a single discipline.

Note from the FA Chair on current catalog language:

“Students seeking the Bachelor of Arts degree may count no more than 54 credit hours in one discipline toward the degree in order to affirm the breadth of study implied in the Bachelor of Arts degree.”
