III. FA Chair's Report – Liz Schmitt

In Memoriam: Vivian Anderson Mosbo

Today we remember Vivian Anderson Mosbo, Emeritus Professor of Mathematics, mother to Chris Mosbo and mother-in-law to Magdalena Mosbo.

Vivian earned her PHD in Mathematics education after raising her two sons, teaching at SUNY Oswego for eleven years. (1999-2009) “Her teaching was marked by her strong belief in academic integrity, both in terms of what she expected from students and what she believed students should expect of her.”

In noting her passing on social media, I found out that Magdalena and I had something in common: We both came out big winners of Mother-in-law Roulette, getting a bonus mom along with a husband. Magdalena noted, “She was the best mother in law anyone could wish for. She was the reason I applied to Oswego, since I had kids (1 and 5 at the time) and knew she would help.”

But beyond these academic pursuits, Vivian had a love of music, learning cello to form a family string quartet with her husband and sons. She was an avid cyclist, doing RAGBRAI across Iowa three times. According to friends in Cortland, “They all thought this 500-mile ride with 5000 people in 100-degree heat was the best vacation they had ever had.” In 1975, Vivian helped start an AWWV (Aid to Women Victims of Violence) chapter in Cortland.

Vivian reminds us how work in the academy enriches us not just through the expertise of our peers, but through the company of an incredibly well-rounded group of colleagues that bring a love of learning to so many things beyond their subject.

Strategic Planning Update: Our facilitator, Dr. Tim Mottet, conducted online focus groups across all of our strategic anchors. As we look ahead to the final plan, I would share an observation by Prabakar Kothandaraman, Dean of the School of Business: A strategic plan needs to be long term, institution-wide, and backed by resources. Review of Academic Officers: There will be elections held shortly for the Dean Review Committees for CLAS and the SOB.

Grade Change Policy: APC will be taking a look at our policy on grade change appeals. The current policy is in the catalog and student handbook. This policy stops at the dean level, with no resource in egregious cases where an instructor is ultimately unwilling to change a grade despite chair and dean determinations. APC encourages comments/feedback on changes to this policy.

Curriculog: The software will shut submissions for program changes/new programs on March 8. For policies and courses, they will need to meet a 4/15 report out, and curriculog will shut off submissions by 4/5.


