4. Explained why the Course Roster Verification deadline happens before the "ADD" course deadline:

Roster Verification is designed to ensure students who have registered have attended before the deadline on the 4th; when students have not attended by that point, it is in everyone's best interest to drop that student. In effect, this is an extension of existing policy for Faculty Drop when students are dropped from our courses where they have missed the first two days of class.

The deadline for Add is also part of college policy and appears in the college catalog. Faculty/departments who don't want to allow students to add their courses that late, can and do ask the Registrar to change the status of the course(s) to "Instructor Permission" to ensure students are not adding at that point without the Prof's permission.

The later the deadline for Roster Verification, the more likely it is for us to see issues in dispersing Financial Aid funds that would then have to be returned to the Federal Government whether the student is later determined to be a no show. The students who never attended this fall (17 this year) will not have any financial liability as a result of this effort.

This fall, our participation rate was around 60%; we were up in the mid 90s last spring.
