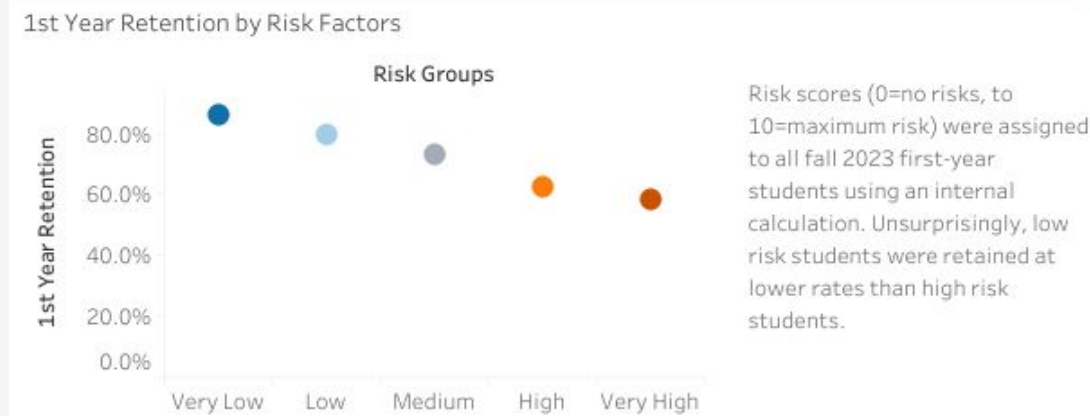
First Year Retention - Preliminary

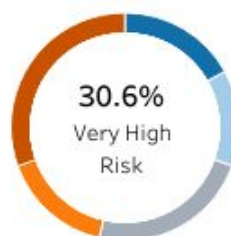
What can we do? **Engagement programs** -- such as being a student athlete or an EOP student -- are one strategy to support student success and retention.
