

# ARTICLE XIV

## ACADEMIC POLICIES COUNCIL

### Section 1. Ex Officio Member

- a. Ex Officio Member
  - o The Vice President for Academic Affairs.
- b. The Faculty Assembly shall elect seven voting members from the faculty with staggered two-year terms. Three shall be elected from the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, one from each of the following three groups: (1) Humanities, (2) Social and Behavioral Sciences, and (3) Natural Sciences, Computer Science, and Mathematics. One shall be elected from the School of Education. One shall be elected from the School of Business. One shall be elected from the School of Communication, Media, and the Arts. One at large faculty member shall be elected.
- c. The Faculty Assembly shall elect one student member with a one-year term.

### Section 2. Function

- a. The Academic Policies Council shall be concerned with long-range planning, organization and evaluation of all academic aspects of the College's undergraduate program, and shall recommend changes in such programs to the Assembly.
- b. A representative of the Academic Policies Council shall sit on the Academic Planning Committee of the Assembly Executive Board.
