WHEREAS the SUNY Board of Trustees 9/10/2015 Resolution on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Policy desires to make SUNY the most inclusive higher education system in the country; and

WHEREAS the SUNY University Faculty Senate passed [Resolution 187-04-1](#) on January 22, 2021, that recognizes and supports Black Lives Matter and for UFS to “strive for anti-racist practices in our individual and collective work at SUNY by committing to addressing the ethical, curricular, operational, professional, and student implications of Black Lives Matter;” and

WHEREAS SUNY UFS [Resolution 187-04-1](#) “encourage campus governance bodies to formally endorse the basic tenets of Black Lives Matter,” and “support the curricular and co-curricular exploration of topics related to Black Lives Matter including, racial (in)equity, (in)justice, and movements for social change, to name a few;”
