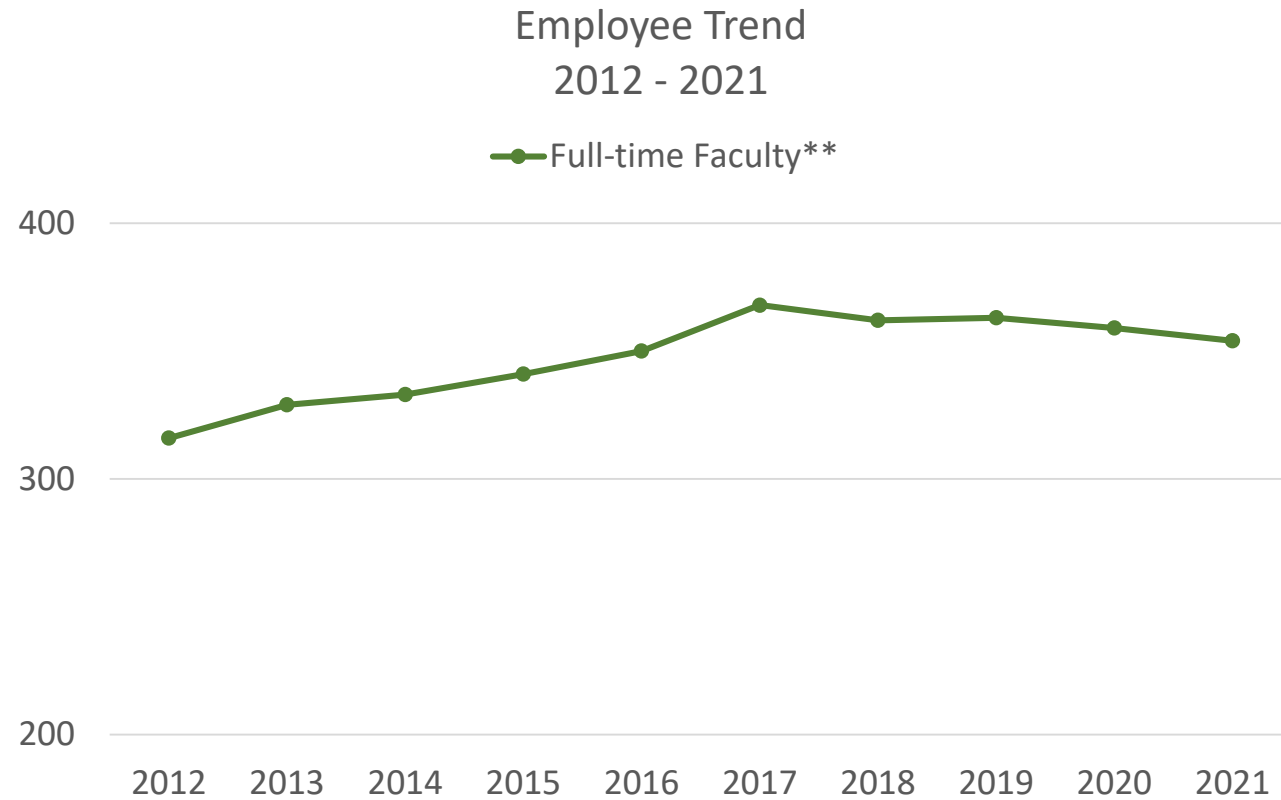

Our Faculty: Research and Creative Activities Philosophy

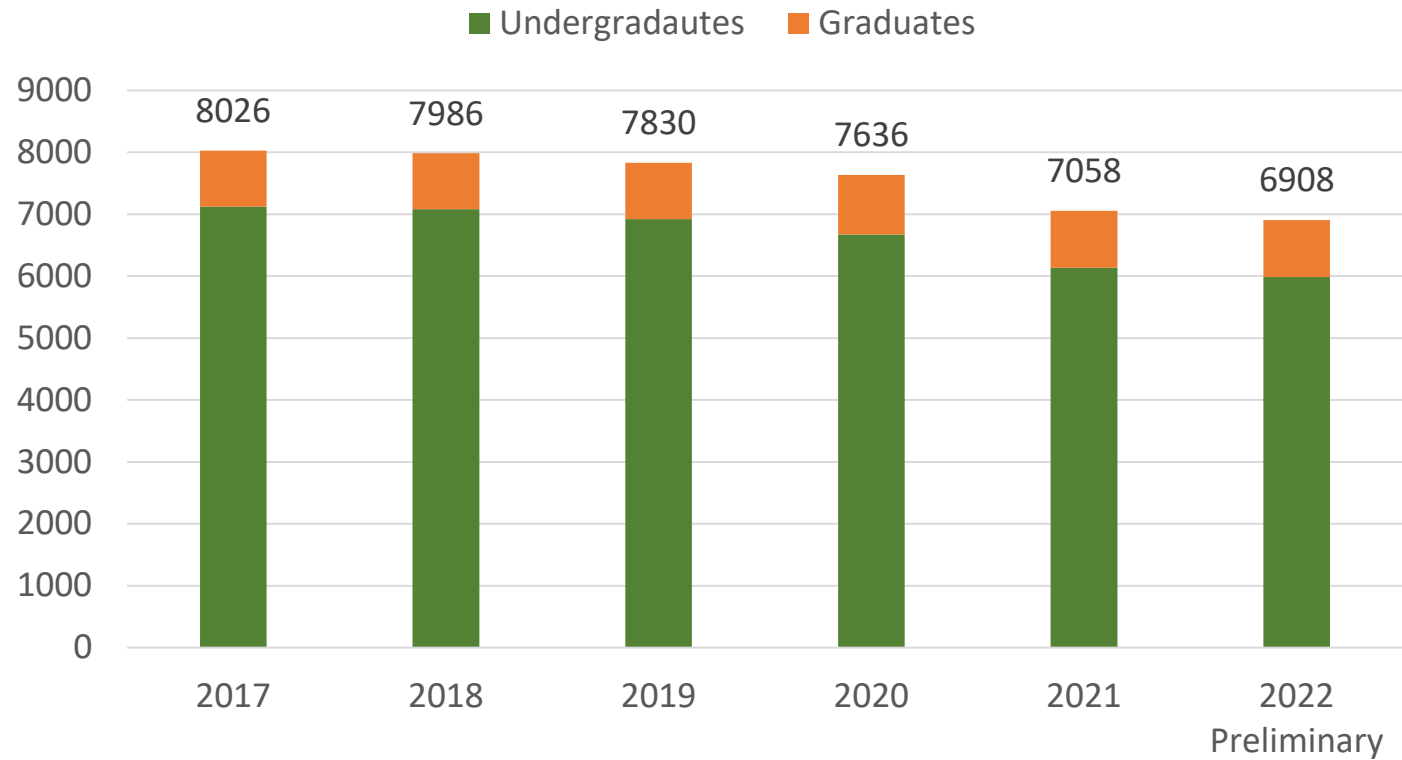
- Purpose

Fall Student Headcounts (excluding Exchange)

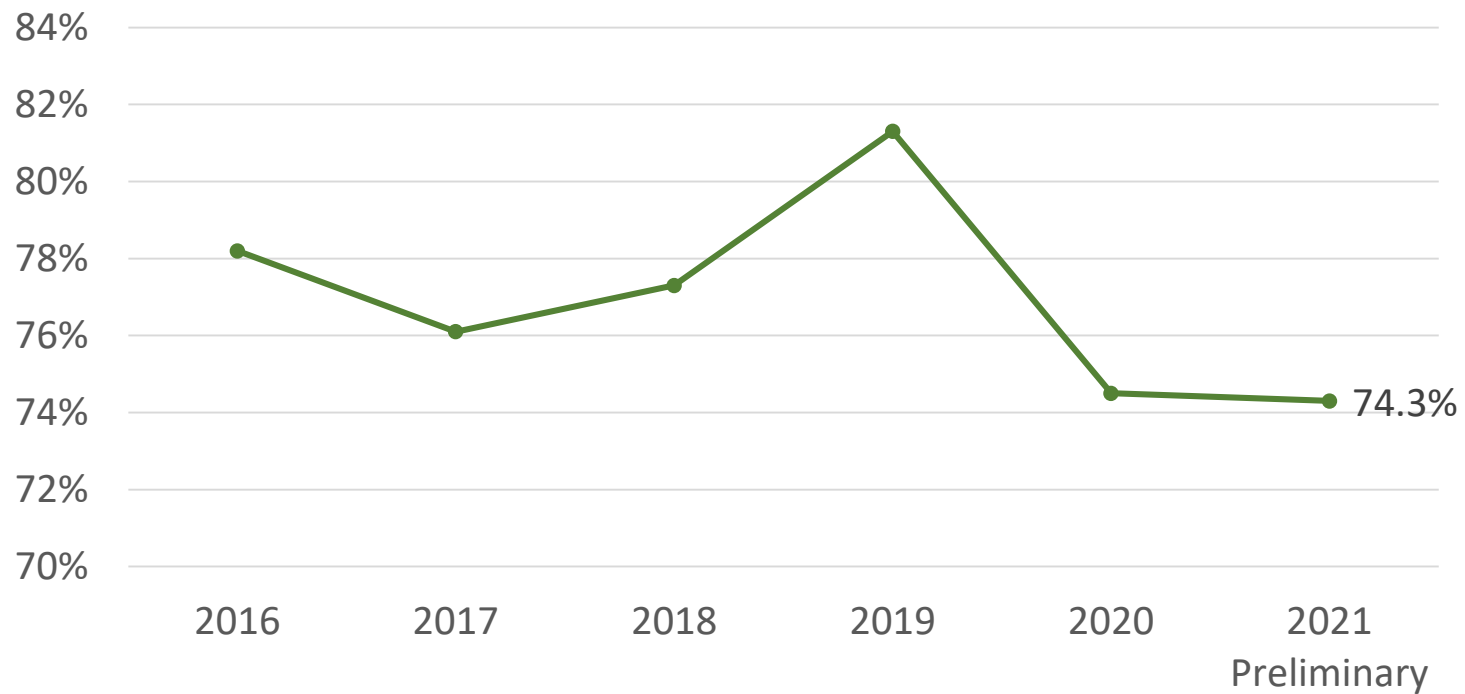

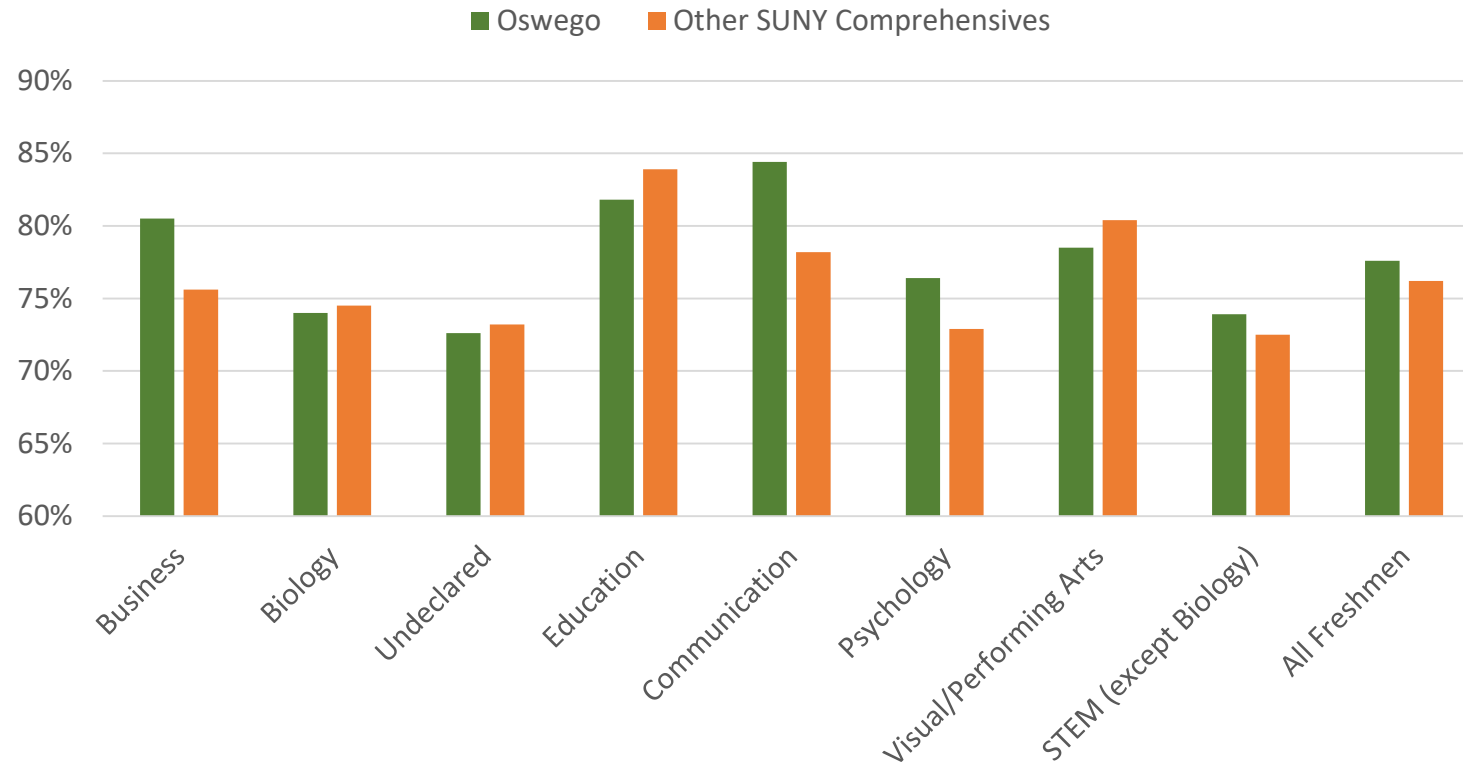

New Full-time Fall Freshmen



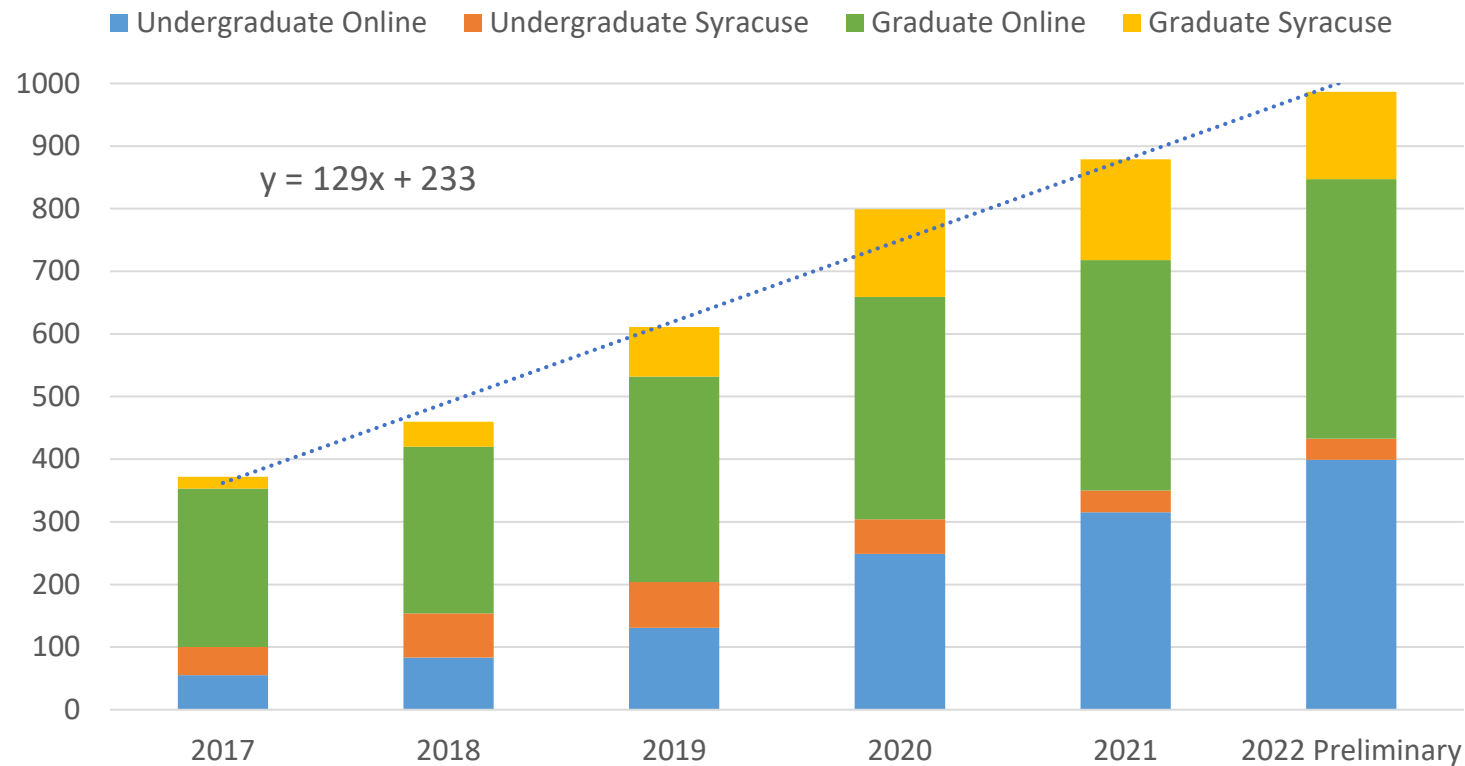

Cohorts from 2016 through 2020 combined



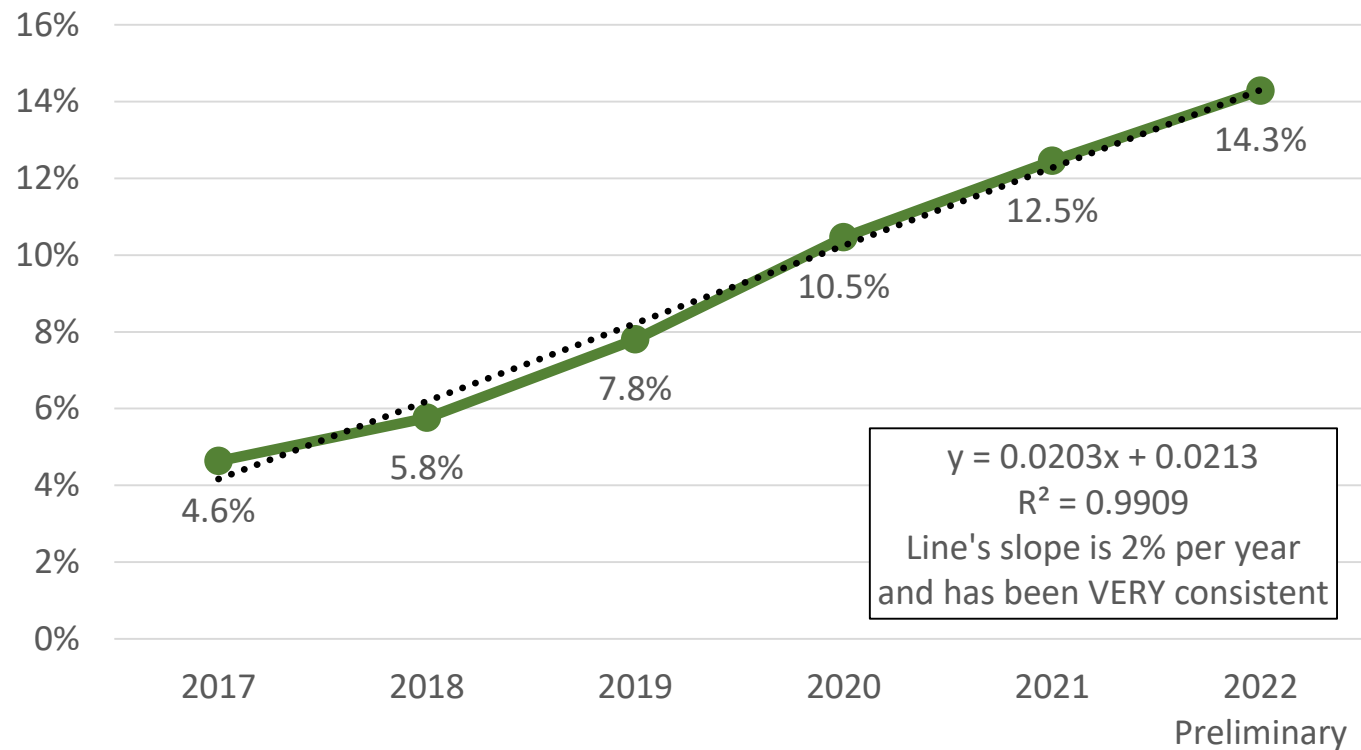
Our Students: Non-Traditional Delivery

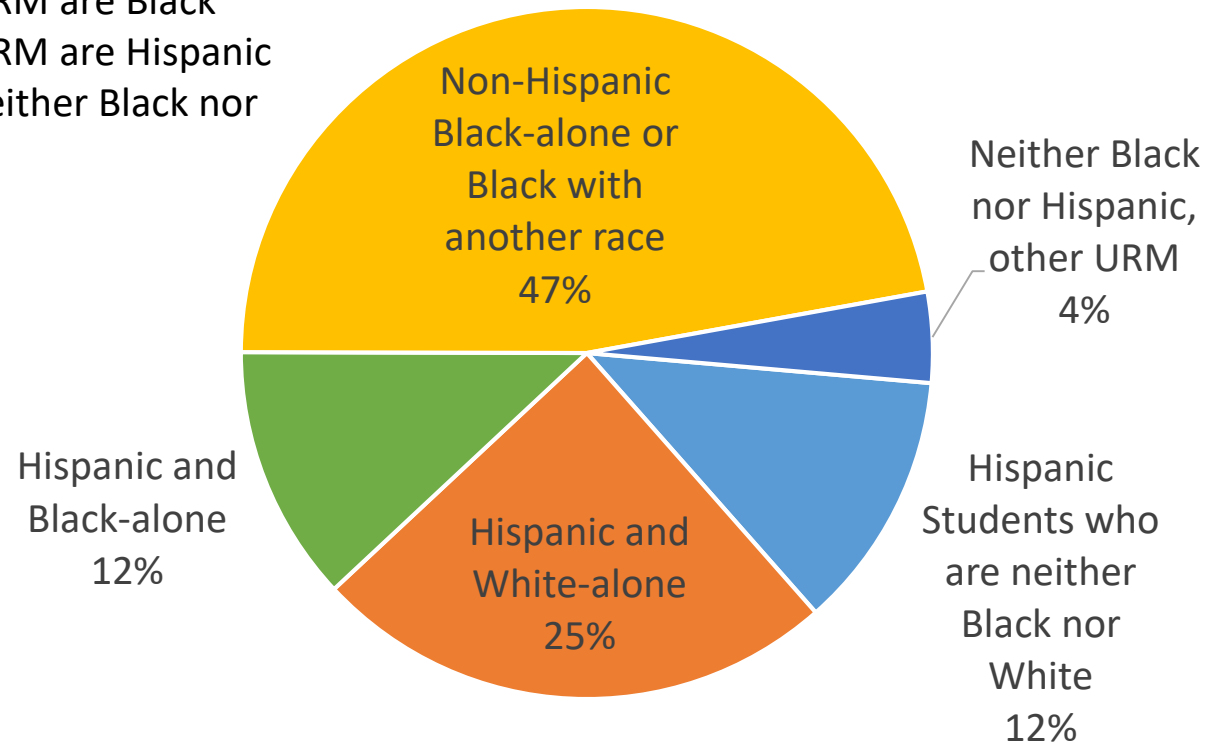
Percent of Total Student Body Enrolled in Online or Syracuse Majors

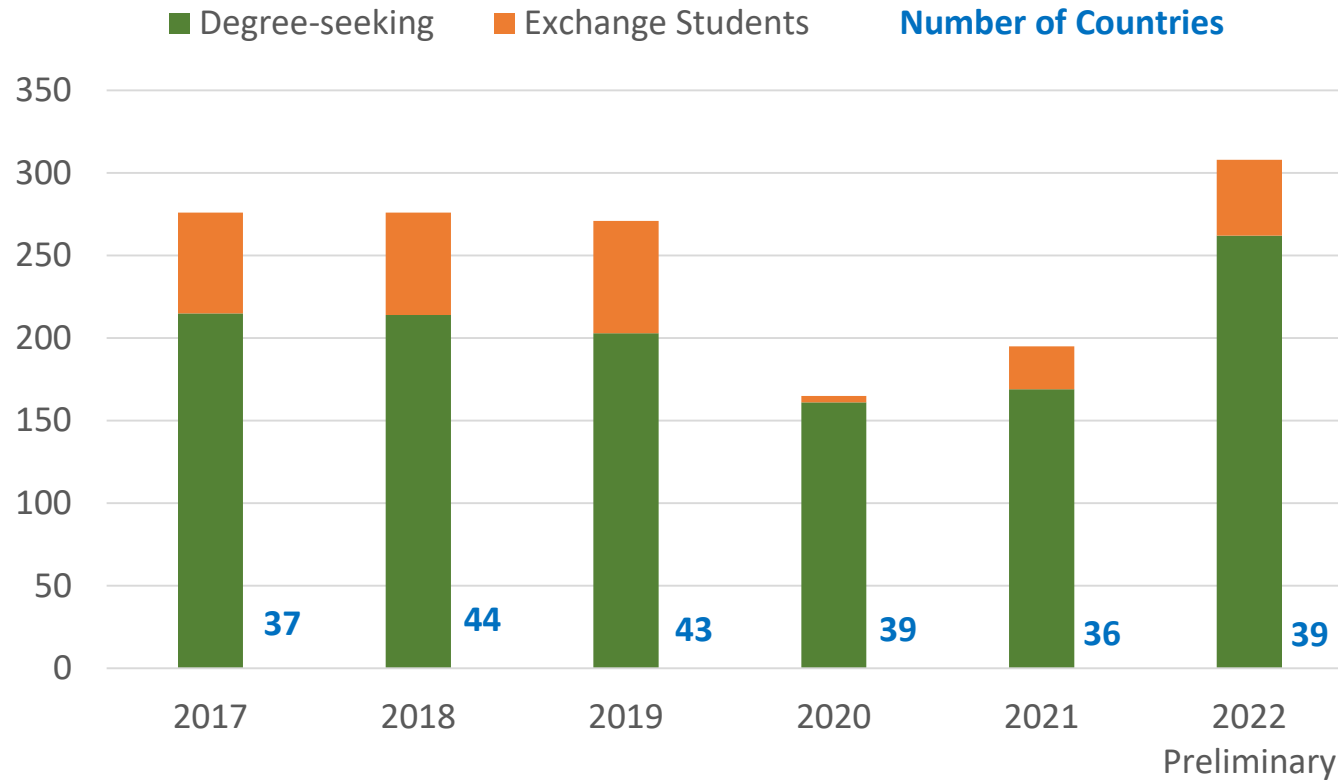
URM Categories, Fall 2022 Preliminary

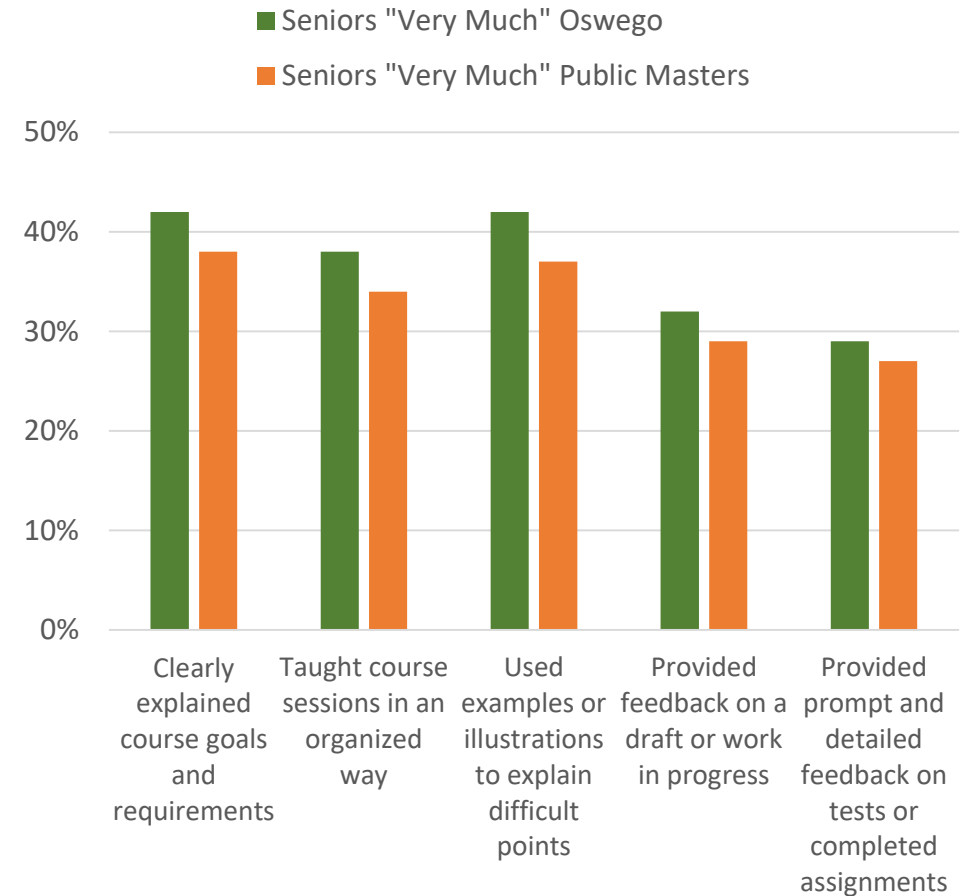
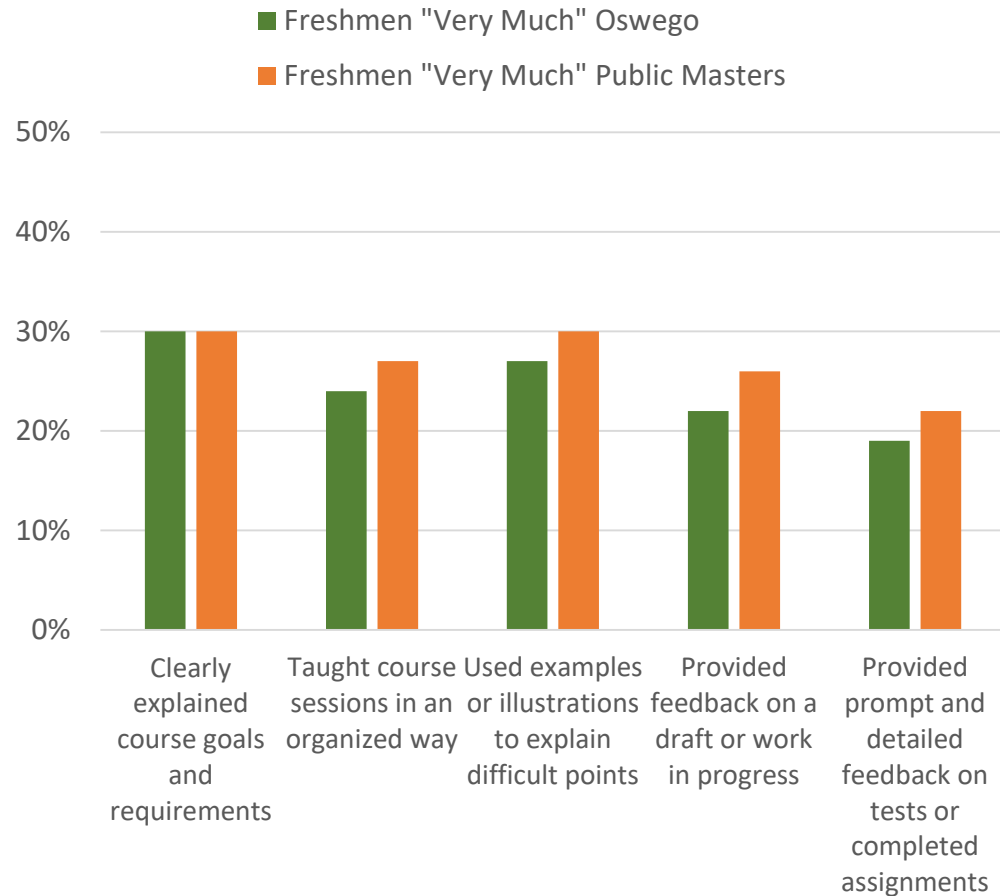

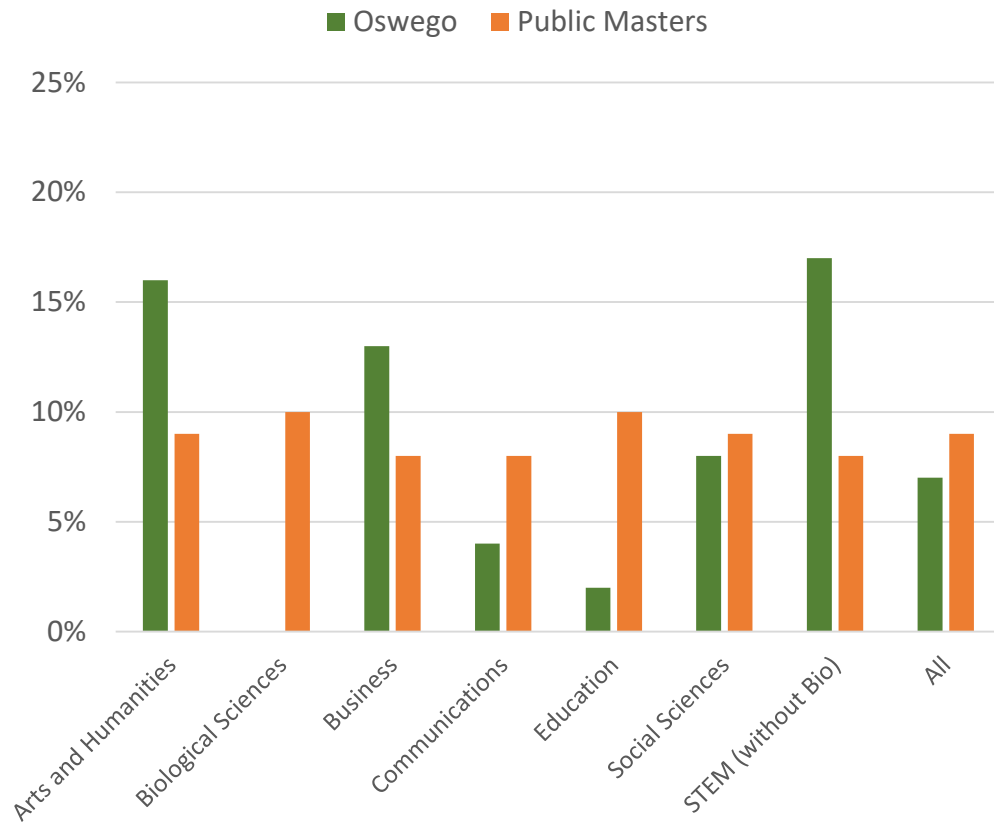

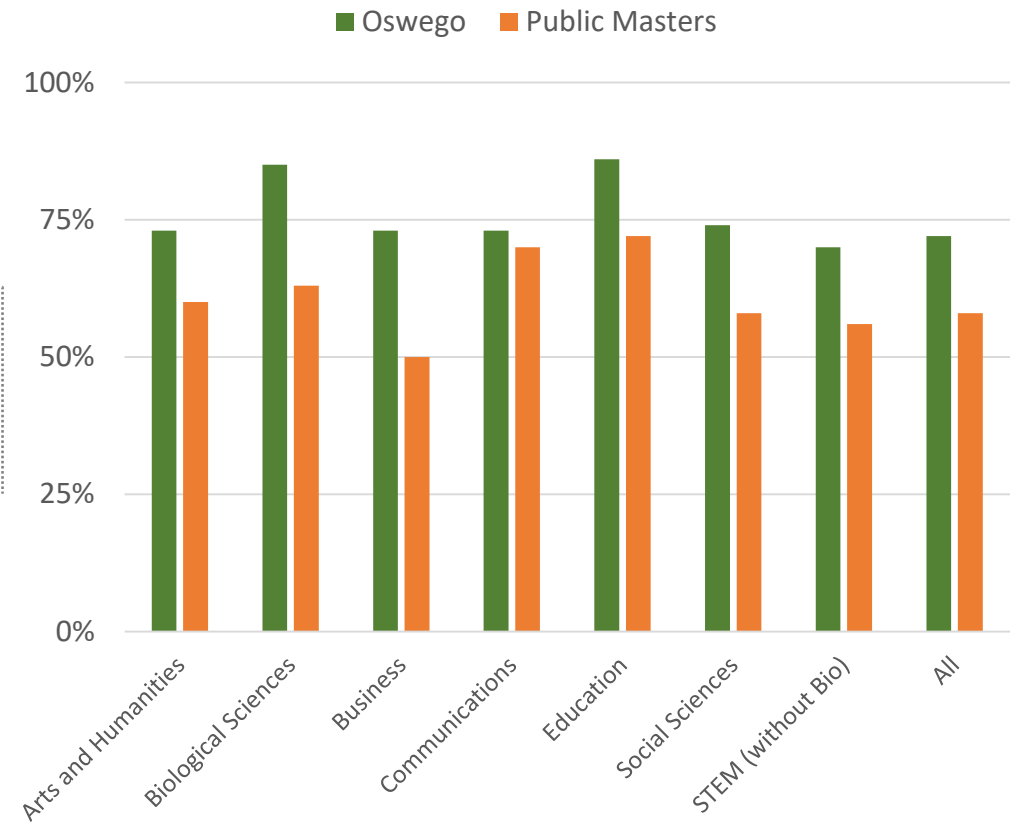

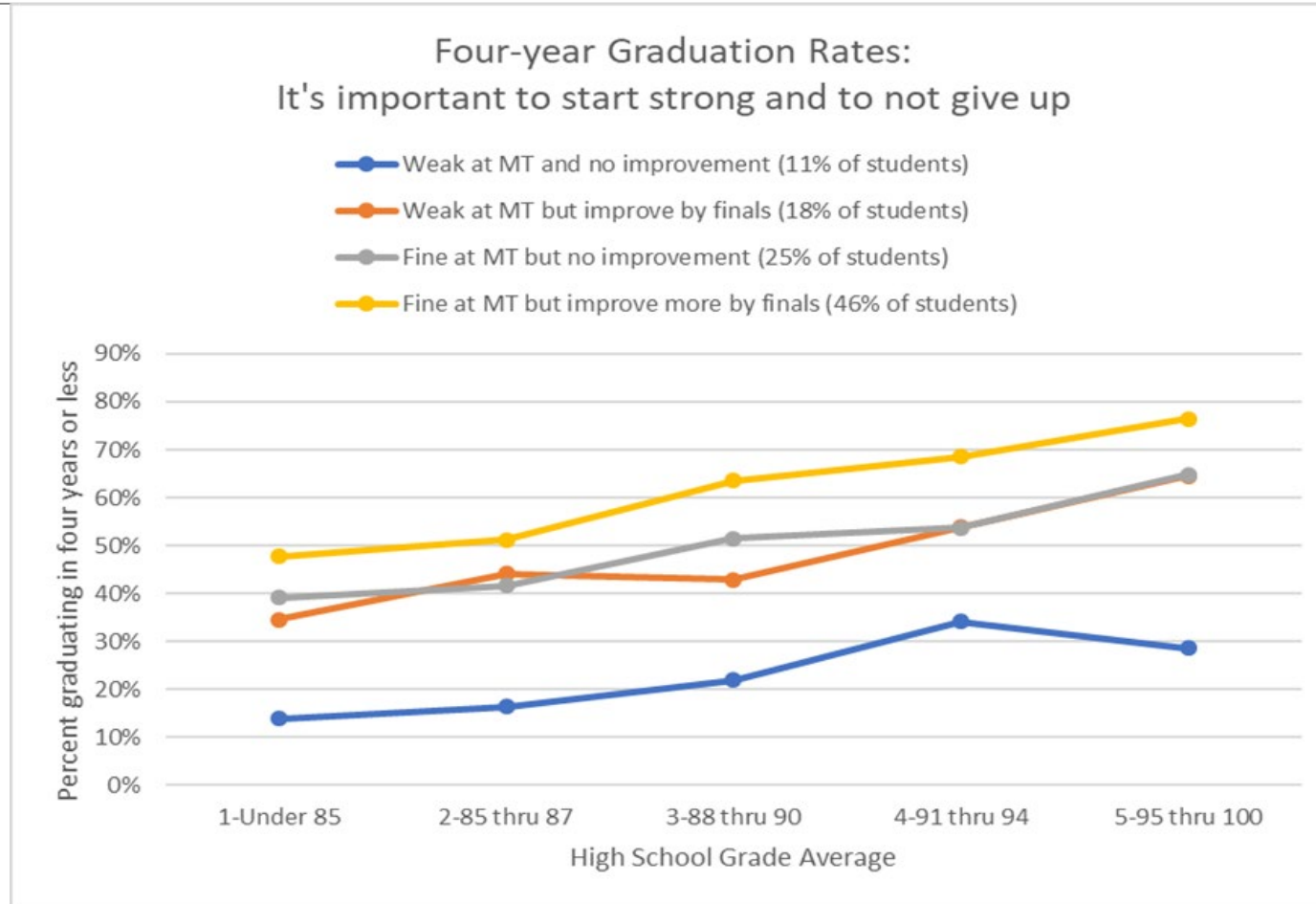
Students reporting 2 or more HIPs: Freshmen



Students reporting 2 or more HIPs: Seniors

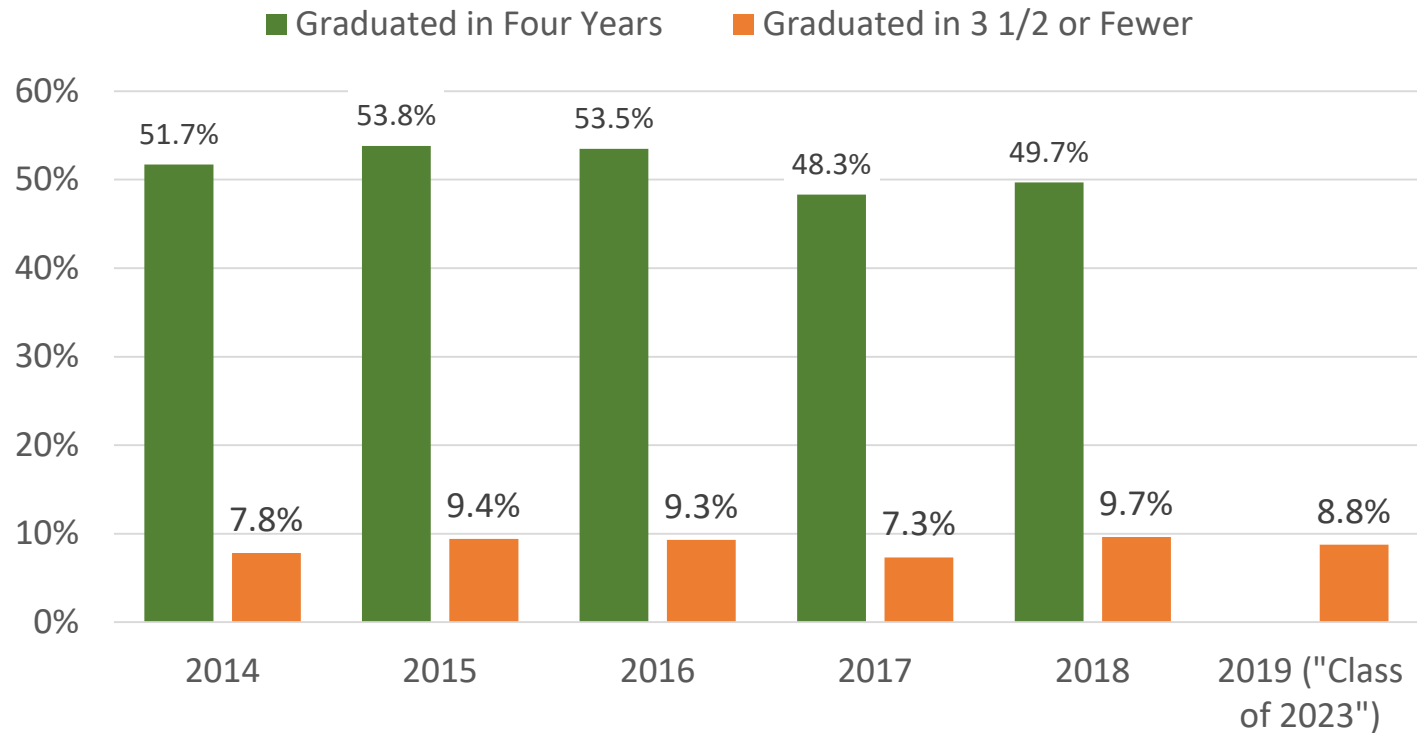
