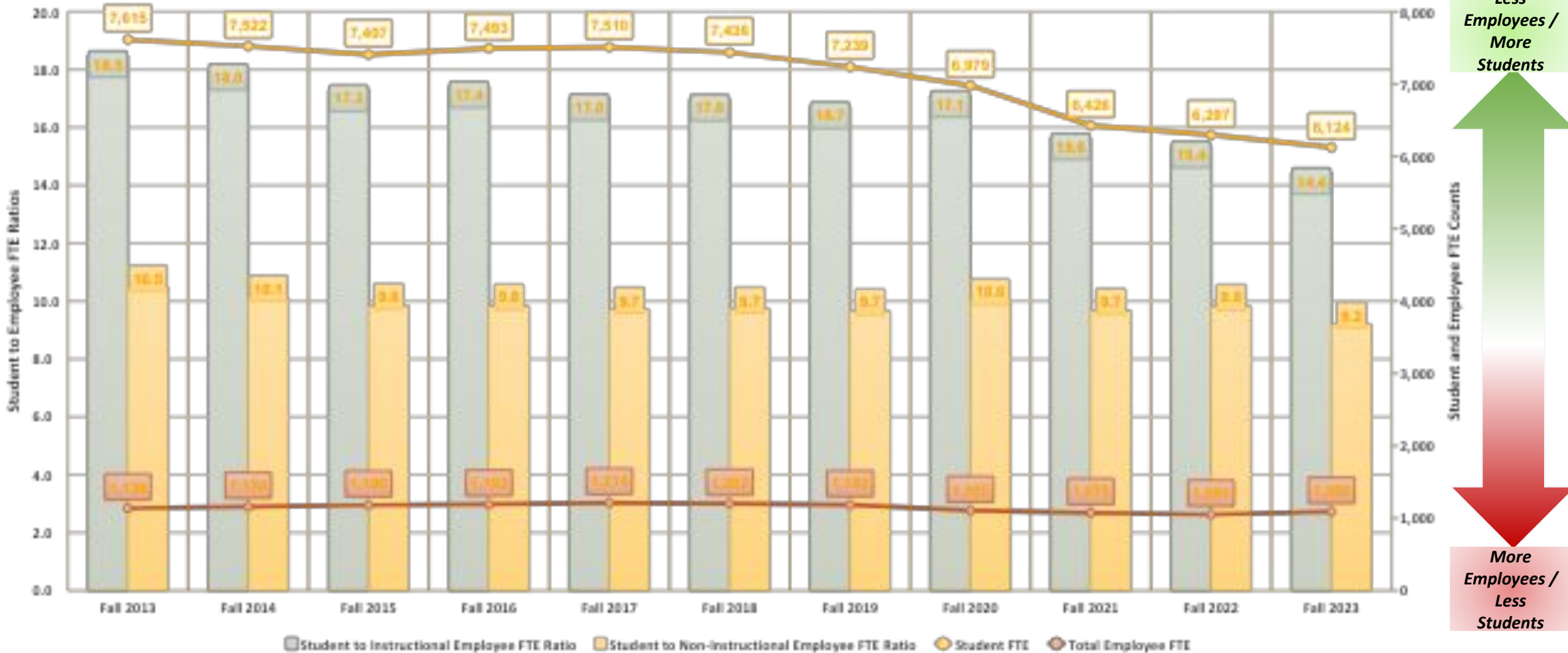
# Faculty Hires for Fall 2025

  - ▶ Meteorology, CS, Crim Justice, Human Dev, Philosophy, Psych

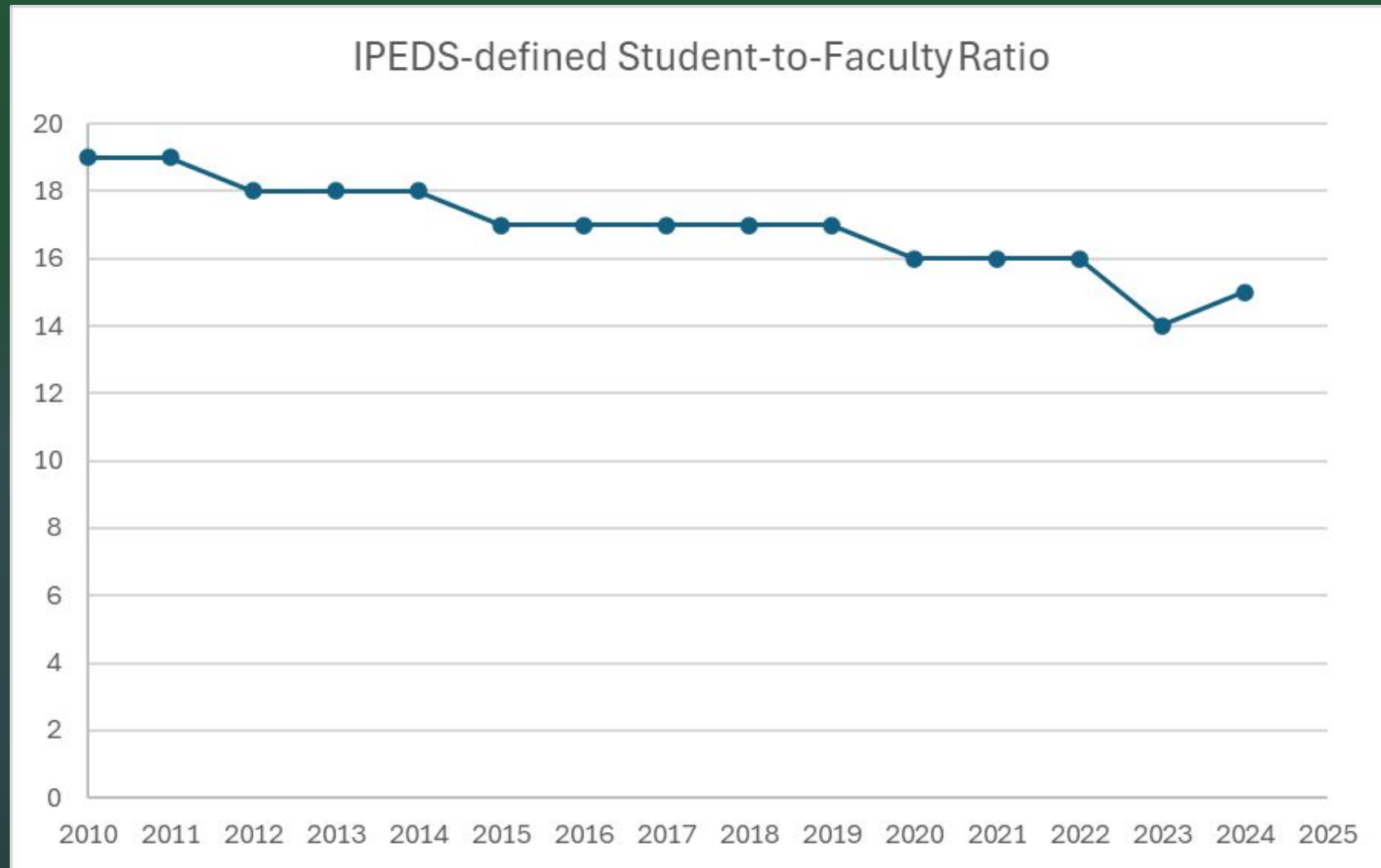

# Student – Faculty Ratio by Year



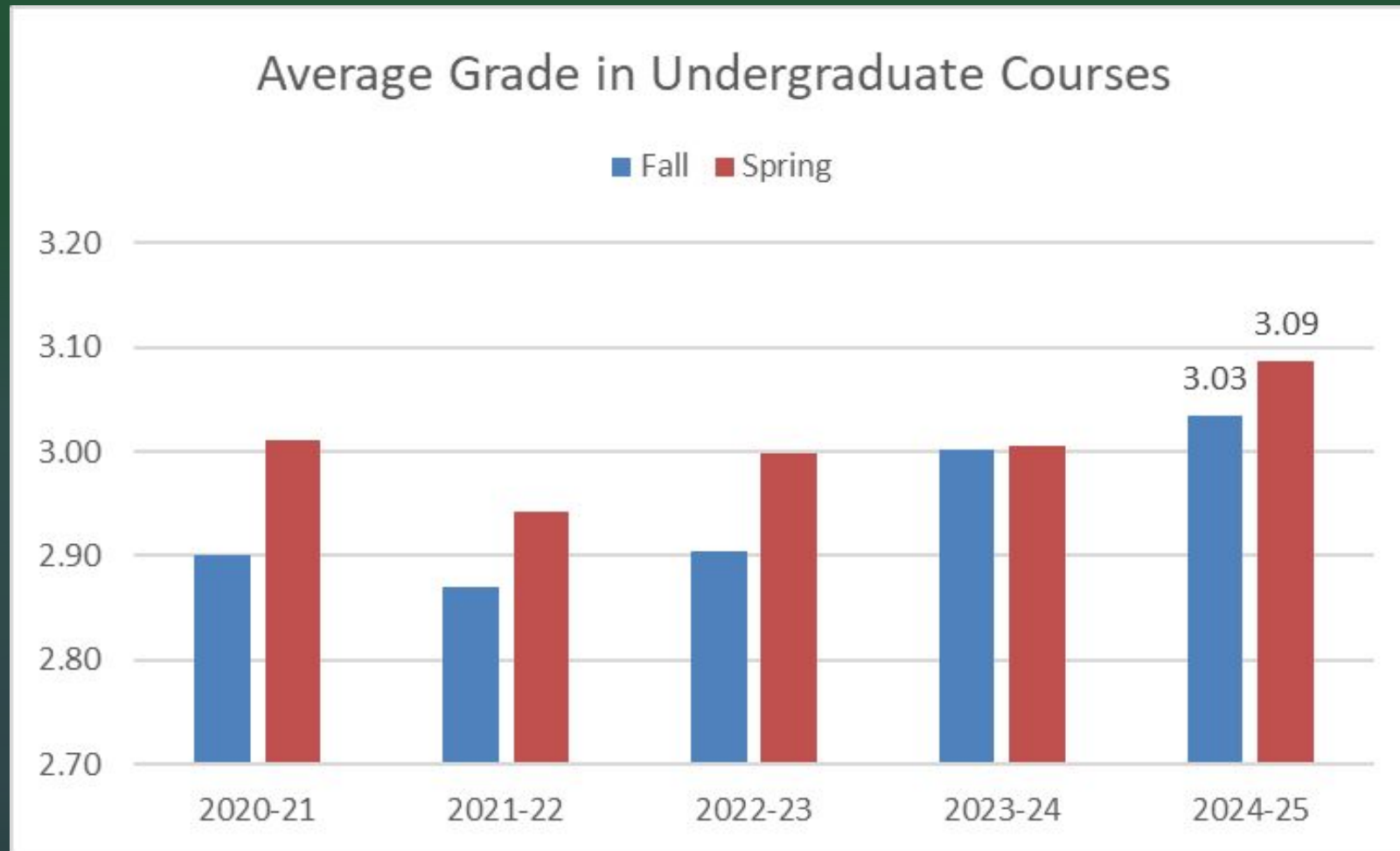
# Academic Momentum

- ▶ Program to improve graduation rates
  - ▶ Focus on retention, 4 and 6 year graduation rates
  - ▶ Focus on 30 credits/year; credit accumulation
  - ▶ Eliminating barriers
- ▶ 4-Year Degree Plans
- ▶ Year-long scheduling
- ▶ Focus on completion and achievement gaps on critical courses
- ▶ Piloting and adopting best practices for student success and belongingness

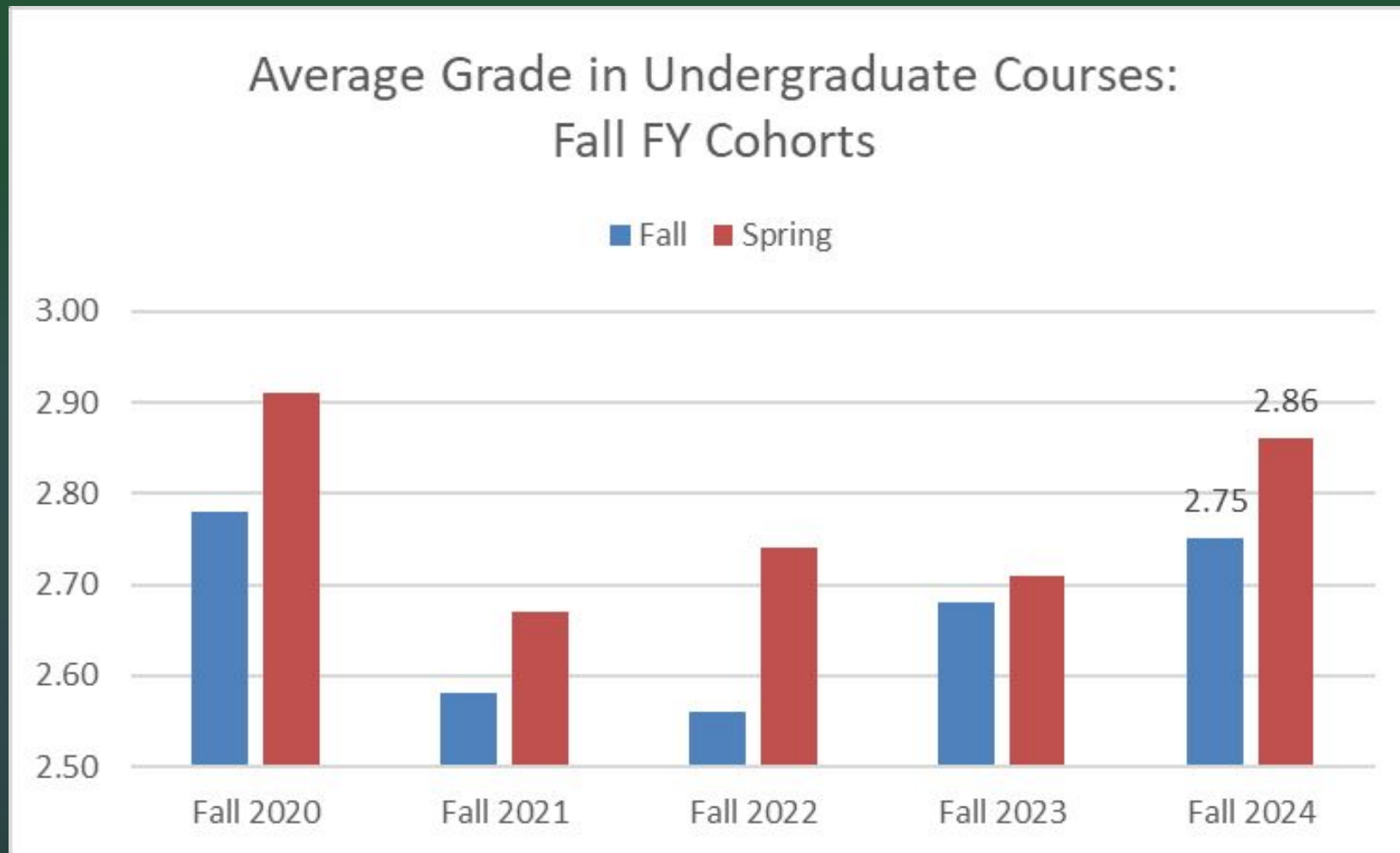
# Ranking Highlights

- #28 in Overall Rank – Reg. Univ (North) - improved *9 spots*
- #12 in Top Public Schools - Reg Univ (North) - improved *2 spots*
- #43 in Best Value Schools - Reg Univ (North) - improved *11 spots*
- #11 in Best Colleges for Veterans - Reg Univ (North) - improved *3 spots*
- #335 in Undergraduate Business Programs - improved *26 spots*
- #297 in Undergraduate Psychology Programs - improved *62 spots*
- #141 for Undergraduate Engineering Programs
- #294 for Undergraduate Computer Science Programs
- Peer assessment score went up from 2.9 to 3.0

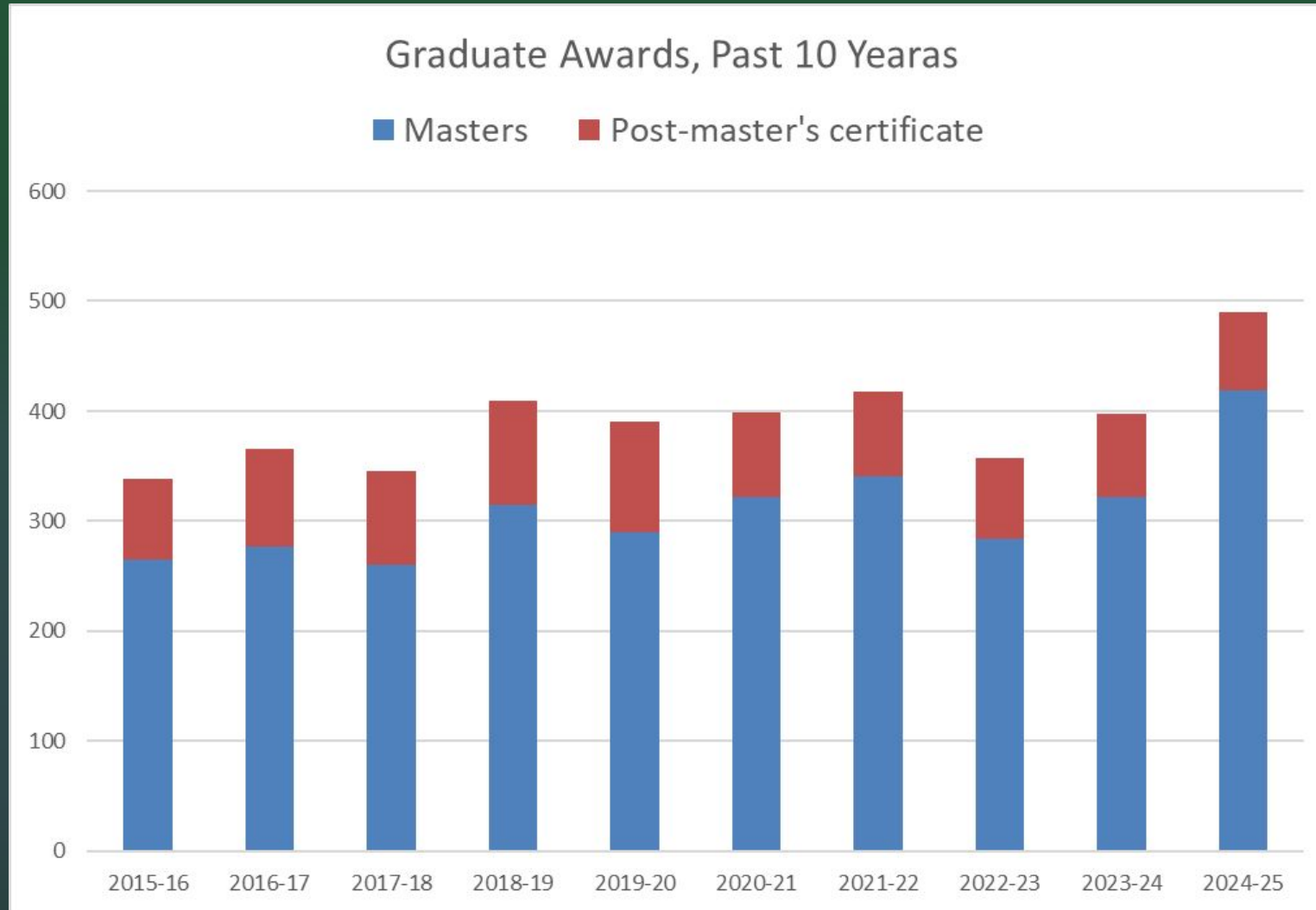
# Student Performance – Undergrad Courses



# Student Performance – First Year Cohorts

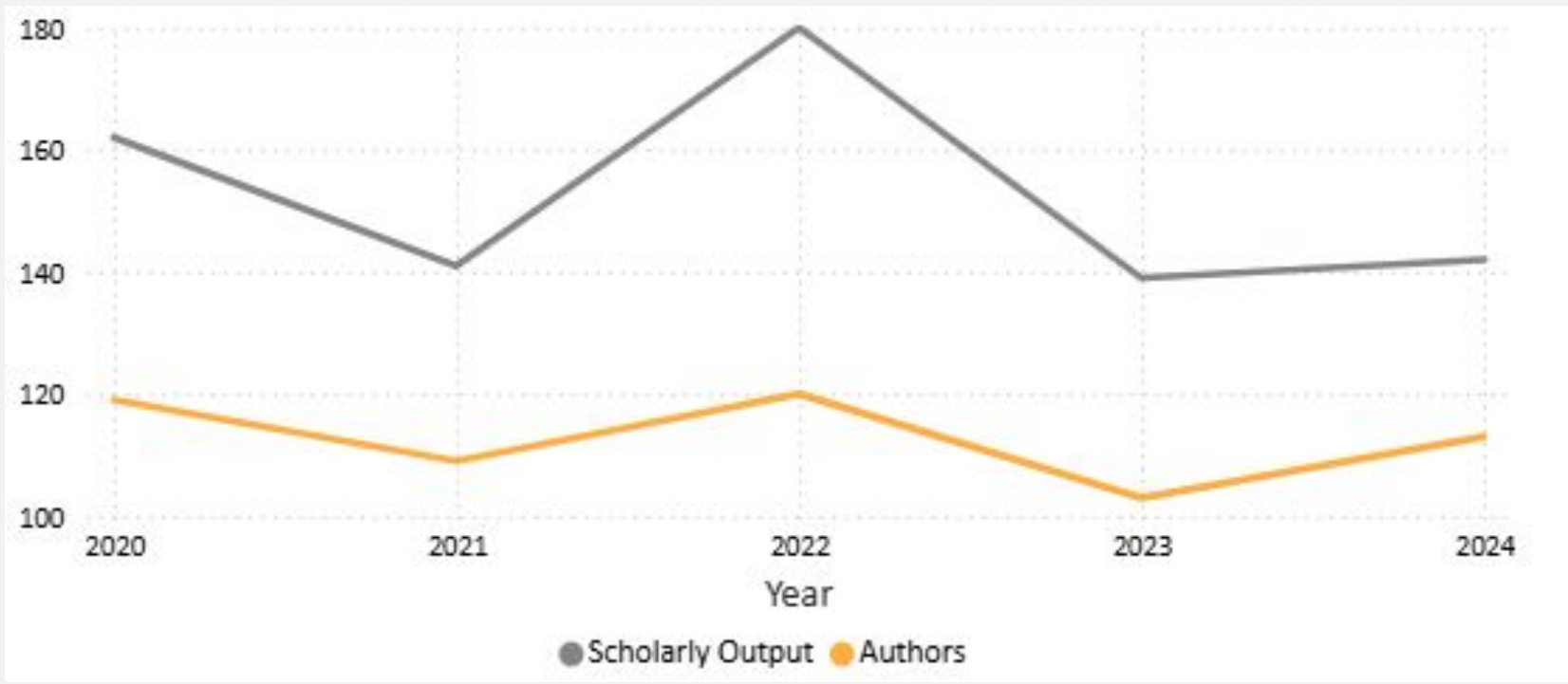


# Student Performance: Graduate Deg Awarded



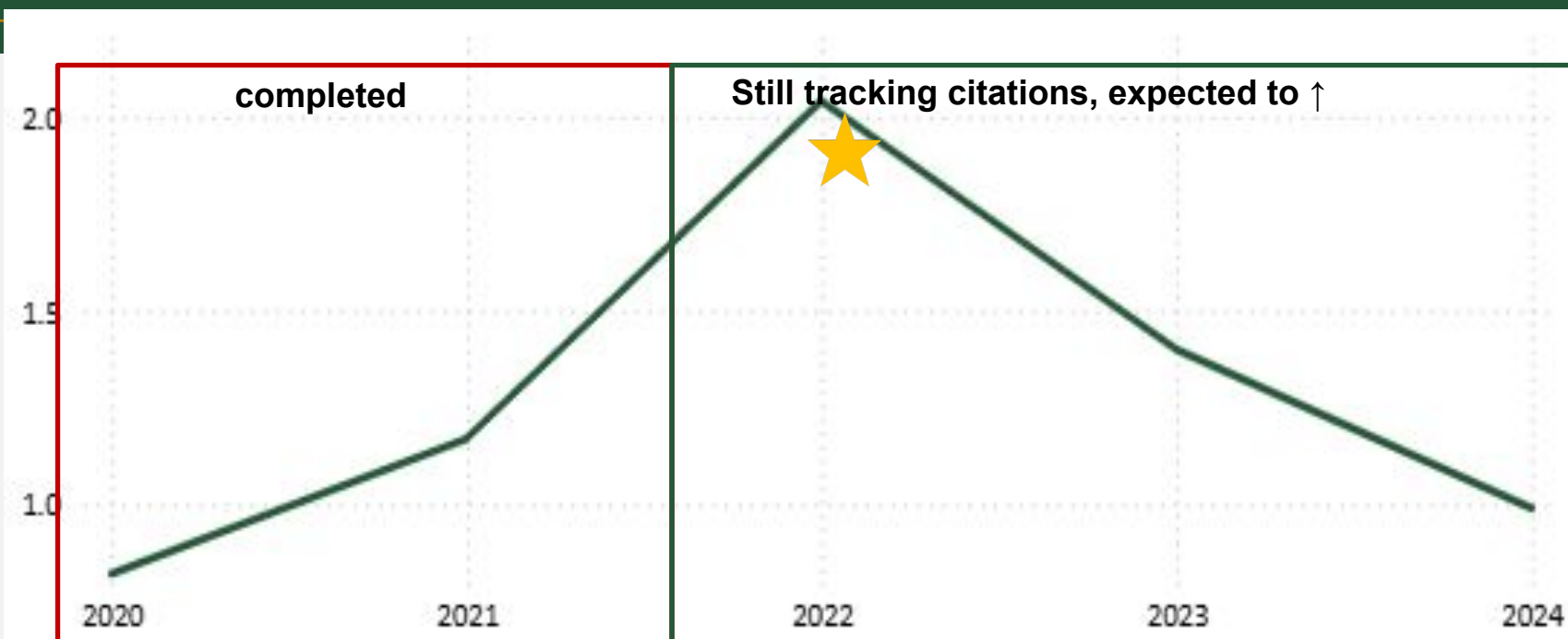

Graph shows Oswego's resilience and potential for renewed scholarly growth.

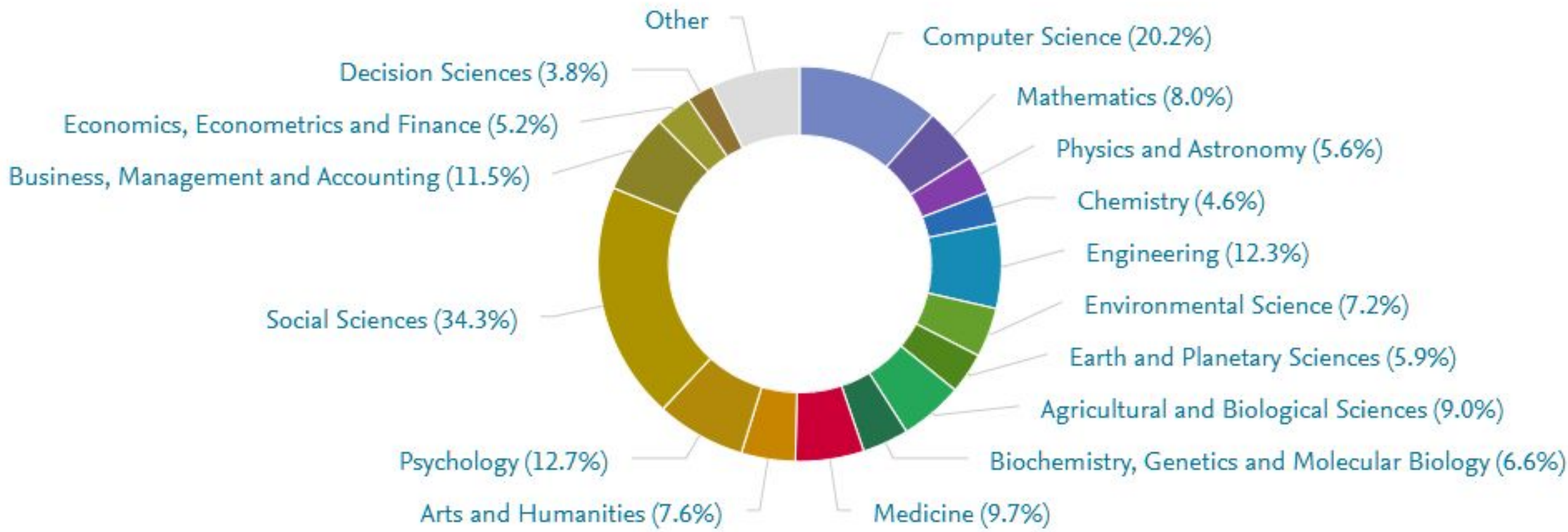
# SUNY Oswego FWCI Over Time



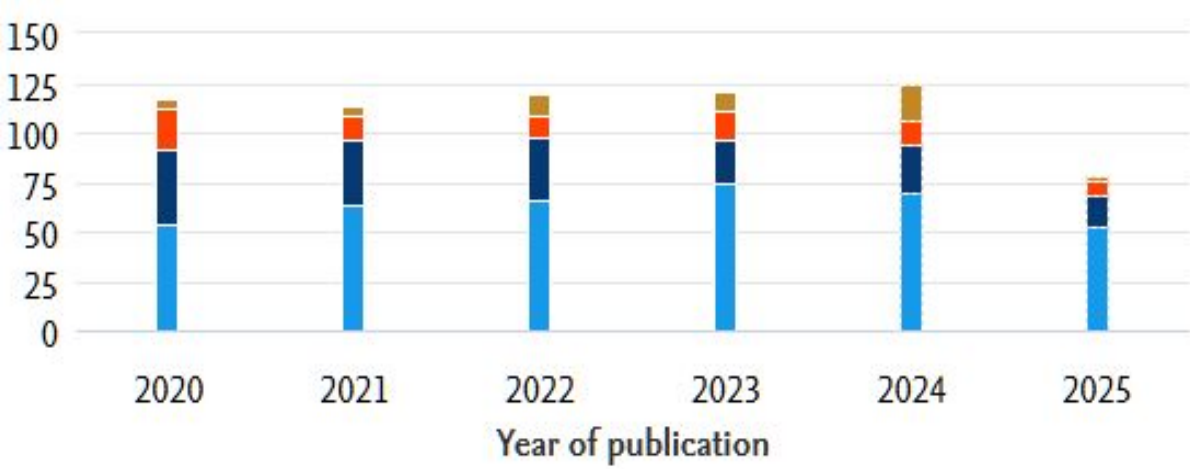
- Field-Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI) measures an entity's publication citations compared to the average for similar works.
- FWCI counts citations from the publication year plus the next three years, showing the impact over time.

2022 group of publications is demonstrating outstanding performance regarding academic impact.
