**A Resolution Reiterating University Faculty Senate
Commitment to Education about Racism and American
History and in Support of the “AAUP Joint Statement on
Legislative Efforts to Restrict Education about Racism and
American History”**

WHEREAS the American Association of University Professors (AAUP) issued a June 16, 2021, statement jointly with more than 100 scholarly associations and organizations stating their “firm opposition to a spate of legislative proposals being introduced across the country that target academic lessons, presentations, and discussions of racism and related issues in American history in schools, colleges and universities”; and

WHEREAS the SUNY University Faculty Senate passed Resolution 189-05-1 on October 9, 2021, that supports the “letter and spirit” of the [AAUP Joint Statement](#) and asked campus governance bodies to individually endorse this statement;
