## FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

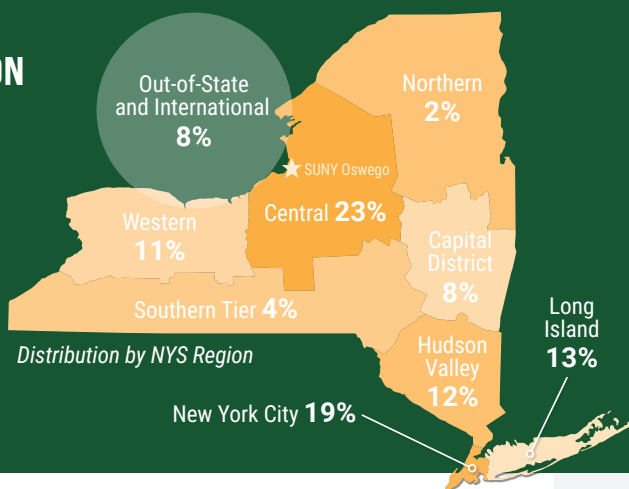
